



RULES

Each campsite allows a maximum of:

2 adults and children

2 vehicles

2 tents if there no recreational equipment on the campsite or 1 tent if there is already recreational equipment.

All other persons on the campsite are considered visitors and must register at the office and pay the appropriate fees.

All other vehicles or bicycles which can't park on campsite must park in the visitor parking lot. No vehicles will be allowed to park on the road.

The following schedule must be respected:

11:00 PM - Visitors leave campground;

11:00 PM to 08:00 AM - Quiet time (curfew);

01:00 AM - Fire completely extinguished;

Check out is at 01:00 PM - Campsite must be vacated.

It is forbidden under penalty of fine and/or expulsion to:

Behave in a manner that disturbs others (partying, vulgar language, etc.);

Make excessive noise (loud radios, etc);

Light or have a fire in anywhere other than the fire pits;

Cut wood from the park forests for any purpose including campfires;

Drive mopeds, motorcycles and all terrain vehicles in the park, unless they are your sole means of transportation.

Weapons of any sort such as firearms, air guns, firecrackers, bows & arrows, slingshots or knives are strictly prohibited and they may result in confiscation and or expulsion without refund.

Possession, consumption or trafficking of drugs will result in immediate expulsion without refund. Sobriety is expected at all times on the campground. Alcohol may be consumed at your campsite only. All vehicles operating in the park must respect the speed limit of 15km/hr.

For safety reasons, glass bottles and containers are prohibited on the beach.

Park user must dispose of garbage and waste in the designated area.

Park user must participate in recycling.

Pets are allowed on the campground but not on the beach. They must be on a leash or tied up at all times and their droppings must be collected and disposed of in the garbage, under penalty of fine and expulsion.

Campers must be at least 18 years old to rent a campsite.

Children under 12 years old must be accompanied by an adult when they are on the beach or playground because those areas are not supervised.

At no time must a minor child be left unattended.

Site and equipment must be left clean and in good condition at all times.

Campers who break or destroy equipment through negligence must pay for its repair or replacement. They will also be held responsible for damages caused by their visitors.

Campers must inform the office personnel of their departure.

Do not take shortcuts through sites on foot, bicycle, ATV or other motorized vehicle.

These rules are subject to modification by the management without notice.
